- The stupa will preserve the vast holy dharma activities of H. E. Choden Rinpoche.
- The stupa will be an epicenter for accumulating merit and purifying misdeeds.
- The holy monument will be at the center of a **Three Phase** building project: **Phase One** The stupa and temple, **Phase Two** A free health clinic, **Phase Three** A free school.
- Rinpoche's stupa is a symbol of the ultimate, infinite mind of all buddhas, the dharmakaya, reminding us to emulate our Guru's perfected mind of great bliss directly realizing the nature of reality through the development of compassion and wisdom.
- The building projects will help Rinpoche's reincarnation quickly appear in our world so he can continue the activities of liberating all sentient beings from the sorrows of samsara.
- Building the stupa will help bring peace and harmony to all sentient beings in the world.

The Dimensions and Pertinent Information About H. E. Choden Rinpoche Bodhgaya Stupa are:

- The Building is 60 Feet (18.3 m) High with A Shrine Area 40 Feet (12.2 m) High and the Stupa Is 20 Feet High (6.0 m).
- The Base of Stupa is 60 x 60 Square Feet (18.3 meters squared) (3,600 Hundred Square Feet / 1,097 square meters)
- The Shrine Area Will Hold Approximately 200 People at Full Capacity.
- There Will Be An External Stairway to the Stupa Which Sits On Top of the Shrine Room.
- As Part of This First Phase There Will Be Six Retreat Rooms Available for Monks and Visitors.
